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Conditions of Entry

- Pre-entries will be accepted through online registration via HorseShowsOnline.com. Entry deadline is Wednesday May 8, 2024. Post entries will be charged a late fee of \$30.00 entry. Please have proof of negative coggins and signed AHJA waiver. We only accept cash and checks made out to Fox Lake Farm.
- 2. Fees:
 - a. Class Fee: \$20 each for AHJA recognized.
 - b. Challenge: \$35
 - c. Best Child Rider: \$5 (must have armband)
 - d. Late Entry Fee: \$30 per horse per rider
 - e. AHJA Non-Member Fee: \$10 per rider
 - f. AHJA Office Fee: \$15 per horse per rider
 - g. Paramedic Fee: \$15 per rider
 - h. Day Pen (12x12 pen): \$45
 - i. Paddock (very limited and 3 horses max) \$100
 - j. Stalls: \$60 (extremely limited) contact Guerry Force (205)381-0364
 - k. Print Fee: \$5 per document.
- 3. Hard hats must be always worn while mounted, including schooling. All riders must wear ASTMapproved helmets. Appropriate hunt attire required in conjunction with AHJA rulebook.
- 4. The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, cancel any entries, disqualify exhibitors, prohibit showing of entries and cancel/edit awards of prizes without claims or damages. Management will abide by AHJA rules when combining divisions. Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to weather.
- 5. <u>NO WARM UP ROUNDS</u> Schooling breaks are posted in the schedule for each ring.
- Open schooling will be allowed until 30 minutes prior to each ring's start time. We will water, if needed, and drag rings before the first class. Schooling will be available Friday May 10th from 1:00 -6:00.
- 7. Lunging Ring 4 only
- 8. ALL dogs must always be on a leash.
- 9. Veterinarian on call: Coosa Valley Equine (205)753-0451
- 10. Farrier on call: Mauricio Barrios (205)381-0364
- 11. Ten ribbons will be awarded in the walk-trot and cross rail divisions. All other divisions will pin through 6th. Champion and reserve champion ribbons will be awarded with a champion prize. There will also be a 1st place prize.
- 12. Please observe the dotted line in both hunter rings 1 and 2.
- 13. Show will be held in fenced sand arenas. Two schooling areas will be provided: one fenced with sand footing and one open grass field.

- 14. Horses will not be excused from showing without a veterinarian's certificate showing illness or incapacity of mount. This must be received by the show secretary by the end of the show.
- 15. All scratches and adds must be done at the secretary's desk and proof of scratch/add must be taken to the in gate. No adds or scratches at the gate.
- 16. Light concessions will be provided.
- 17. This show will run under the guidelines of the current AHJA Rulebook. Please see the AHJA website (alabamahunterjumpers.org) for all class specs and cross entering rules prior to entering. On show day the current AHJA Rulebook will be available at the secretary's desk.
- 18. Stabling Stabling must be reserved by contacting Guerry Force 205.381.0364. Stabling reservations are not accepted via HorseShowOnline.com. Stabling is very limited and reserved on first come first served basis. Day stalls and pen will be available starting at 7:00am Saturday.

Hunter Classics & Best Child Rider

*200. **\$500 Fox Lake Farm Challenge \$35.00:** Open to all riders showing in children's pony, regular pony, pre-child/adult hunter, baby green hunter, modified hunter, low hunter, children's hunter, adult amateur hunter, regular hunter, and junior/AO hunter. Second hunter rounds will be scored for the challenge. Each horse rider combination may only have one round count towards the challenge. Pinning through 8^{th} – payout: \$130, \$95, \$75, \$65, \$45, \$30, \$30, \$30 (payout will be made via check).

201. Best Child Rider on a Pony Ring I - \$5.00- open to all junior riders (on a pony) in hunter ring I who are showing in schooling pony, children's pony and regular pony. This award will be given out to the pony rider who the judge feels best displays riding talent, horsemanship and sportsmanship during the show day. Riders must display the colored armband to be considered for this award. Armbands will be given out by the secretary. Riders may only compete in one best child rider category.

202. **Best Child Rider on a Horse Ring I - \$5.00** – Open to all junior riders (on a horse) in hunter ring I who are showing in schooling hunter, pre-child, low hunter, modified hunter, baby green, children's hunter, junior hunter and regular working hunter. This award will be given out to the junior rider who the judge feels best displays riding talent, horsemanship and sportsmanship during the show day. Riders must display the colored armband to be considered for this award. Armbands will be given out by the secretary. Riders may only compete in one best child rider category.

203. **Best Child Rider on a Pony Ring II - \$5.00** – Open to all junior riders (on a pony) in hunter ring II who are showing in walk-trot, cross rails, hopeful hunter, short stirrup, long stirrup and starting hunter. This award will be given out to the pony rider who the judge feels best displays riding talent, horsemanship and sportsmanship during the show day. Riders must display the colored armband to be considered for this award. Armbands will be given out by the secretary. Riders may only compete in one best child rider category.

204. **Best Child Rider on a Horse Ring II- \$5.00** – Open to all junior riders (on a horse) in hunter ring II who are showing in walk-trot, cross rails, hopeful hunter, short stirrup, long stirrup and starting hunter. This award will be given out to the junior rider on a horse who the judge feels best displays riding talent, horsemanship and sportsmanship during the show day. Riders must display the colored armband to be considered for this award. Armbands will be given out by the secretary. Riders may only compete in one best child rider category.



WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

For and in consideration of the AHJA's acceptance of my membership and/or, if a non-member, allowing me, the undersigned, or my minor child, to participate in any capacity in an AHJA sanctioned or approved event or activity ("AHJA-sponsored event") during **2024**, including but not limited to equestrian shows, competitions, clinics, practices and related or incidental activities and events. I, for my myself, and on behalf of my minor child, or minor for who I am guardian of, hereby agree as follows:

- A. AHJA RULES AND POLICIES: I agree to be bound and to abide by the rules and policies of the AHJA as published on its website at www.alabamahunterjumpers.org, and as amended periodically.
- B. I knowingly, willingly and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with equestrian sports, and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that any AHJA-sponsored event involves risks and dangers, including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury, sickness and disease, including communicable diseases among humans or animals, trauma, pain and suffering, bites, kicks, abrasions, contusions or other injury or disability, allergic reactions, falls, paralysis, death, loss or damage to personal property, including without limitation to trailers, vehicles, tack, equipment, horses or other animals, and other unknown risks and dangers.
- C. I understand that horses can be unpredictable and may buck, rear, fall, bolt, bite, kick or engage in other dangerous behaviors that pose a hazard to themselves, property, other animals, and humans. I further understand that horse equipment may fail or malfunction and that the premises may have hazards such as uneven ground, personnel, heavy equipment, wildlife, animals, and other potential risks.
- D. To the best of my knowledge and belief, I have no physical or mental restriction(s) which would prohibit my handling, riding and/or being in the vicinity of horses and/or farm, horse stable, horse event premises activities.

I specifically acknowledge that Alabama and the United States is currently battling the pandemic associated with COVID-19, a highly transmissible infectious disease, and agree that I will comply with any and all safety measures instituted by the AHJA and the AHJA-sponsored event, and further agree that I knowingly, willingly and voluntarily acknowledge and assume and take sole responsibility for the risks associated with participating in AHJA-sponsored events during the COVID-19 pandemic and its aftermath. I also agree to abide by any biosecurity protocols set forth by the AHJA related to human or equine participants.

I HEREBY VOLUNTARILY AND KNOWINGLY ASSUME ANY AND ALL SUCH RISKS AND AGREE THAT I AM SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGES, LIABILITIES, LOSSES, OR EXPENSES THAT I INCUR AS A RESULT OF MY, MY MINOR CHILD'S, OR MINIOR IN WICH I AM GUARDIAN OF, PARTICIPATION IN

ANY AHJA-SPONSORED EVENT. I ALSO AGREE TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY INJURY OR DAMAGE CAUSED BY ME, MY HORSE, MY SPOUSE OR CHILD, AND ANY OTHER PERSON OR ANIMAL ACTING UNDER MY DIRECTION AND CONTROL, AT ANY AHJA EVENT.

- E. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: in consideration of my participation in any AHJA-sponsored event in 2024, I hereby release, waive, and agree not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the AHJA, its members, and members of its governing body, host farms/facilities, and all persons associated with AHJA activities, whether paid or volunteer, including all persons associated with and any host farm or event location associated with any sanctioned, sponsored, or affiliated show, schooling day, clinic, gathering or event in association with the AHJA, this also includes participants (including athletes/riders, coaches trainers, judges and other personnel), owners, guests, licensees, officials, show managers, grooms, employees, promoters, sponsors and advertisers, with respect to any liability claims, demands, causes of action, damages, losses, or expenses, including but not limited to court costs and attorneys' fees, of any kind which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in AHJA-sponsored events, including claims for liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the aforesaid persons.
- F. ELECTRONIC SIGNATURES AND AUTHORITY TO SIGN: Signees and the AHJA agree that a facsimile, scanned or other form of my electronic signature on this Agreement is considered to be original and is as legally binding as my handwritten signature. Each individual signing this Agreement on behalf of a Party thereto represents and warrants that such individual is fully authorized to do so, and that this Agreement is fully binding on that Party.
- G. MERGER AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: This Waiver and Release of Liability represents the complete agreement between the parties hereto, and no oral representations, statements or prior agreements have been made apart from the terms specified herein. If any provision of this Waiver and Release of Liability is held to be unlawful, void or unenforceable for any reason, then that provision shall be deemed severable and shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the remaining provisions.
