### **NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED – UNDER ALABAMA LAW**

Each horse is required to submit a printed current copy of a negative coggins test to the show office BEFORE A BACK NUMBER WILL BE ISSUED. Trainers: please have all proper documents when you check in with the office.

If you will be traveling from outside the state of ALABAMA you must have a health certificate signed by a licensed veterinarian WITHIN 30 DAYS prior to arriving to the show grounds. Keep certificates with you while on property.

### **STABLING, RV, HAY, AND SHAVINGS**

To reserve stabling and shavings you must email AHJApresident@gmail.com directly by February 24, 2021. If you do not, we will not guarantee you a stall and you will not have shavings.

### **SCHOOLING SCHEDULE**

Thursday: Rings open from 10:00 am - 5:00 pm. Flatting in schooling rings is available starting at 9:00am. The office will be open from 2 – 4.

Friday & Saturday: schooling allowed till 7:30 am

Sunday: Rings are closed prior to show start time. The schooling rings are open prior to show time.

**\$1,500 Hunter Derby 700:** First round course will be a minimum of eight obstacles. Fences will be set at 2'6" with a minimum of two 3' option fences. The top twelve scores will return for a handy course consisting of at least eight jumps or more. The top eight riders will ride for ribbons. Formal dress attire is recommended. The class is open to all juniors, amateurs, and professionals. 10 Entries are needed to fill the class - will ribbon to 8<sup>th</sup>.

**\$250 AHJA Challenge 802:** Open to all riders competing in short stirrup, long stirrup, children's pony, and regular pony. Challenge will be open all day and run at all fence heights. This is a one round classic with the hunter II from each qualifying division getting scored. 8 entries are needed to fill the class. Open to juniors and amateurs. Riders cannot cross enter into the \$1,500 Derby. Will ribbon through 6<sup>th</sup>.

**\$500 Jumper Pairs Class 804:** A power and speed style course open to all juniors, amateurs and professionals. Fences will be set at .75m and must have a partner to participate. Open to all hunters and jumpers. 8 entries are needed to fill the class. Will ribbon through 6<sup>th</sup> and will pay out to 6<sup>th</sup> place and prize money will be split between each pair. Riders must be present for a rider's meeting prior to the start of the class.

**Junior Board Equitation Challenge 900/901:** Flat class open to all juniors and amateurs who did not win the previous eq challenge. To be judged on equitation on the flat. The judges may choose from the USEF 19 Equitation tests. No help is allowed from the rail (trainer, parent, friend, or spectator). Riders who receive help from the rail will be disqualified.

**\$150 Beginner Challenge 801:** Open to any rider showing in any section of walk trot, Crosspole, or hopeful hunter. Challenge will be open all day and run at all fence heights. This is a one round classic with the hunter II from each qualifying division getting scored his is a one round classic which will be scored (hunter II). 8 entries are needed to fill the class. Open to juniors and amateurs. Riders cannot cross enter into the \$1,500 Derby or the \$250 AHJA Challenge. Will ribbon through 6<sup>th</sup>

**\$250 .85m/1.0m Classic -701** Open to all riders eligible to compete in the .85m or 1.0m. To be run in a table II, section 2b format - Formal jumper attire required. Riders showing multiple heights will be required to jump the higher of the two options. Riders will ride for ribbons. Will pin 1-8.

Information/Rules and Regulations

The Horse Show Management reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to, or arising out of, or incident to, the Show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by Show Management, its decision to be final. The Horse Show Management reserves to itself the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to change any course, to cancel or combine any classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; use dotted line; and to change the specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants. Every horse entered herein for competition will be under control of the Show Management, but the Show Management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Horse Show, officials, employees, Officers, director, Sponsors, and Facility Owners blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employees, or equipment. All owners and exhibitors shall be responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents or employees, to stalls, buildings and other properties on the showgrounds, and shall be billed accordingly.

STALLS: Stalls will be available at H & G Horse Quarters at a cost of \$130 per stall, beginning Thursday at 8:00 am. NO INITIAL BEDDING IS PROVIDED. Stalls will be assigned as requested. Stalls must be reserved via email ([ahjapresident@gmail.com](mailto:ahjapresident@gmail.com)) by February 24, 2021. This is a non-refundable fee.

TRAILER PARKING: Trailer parking in designated areas only. The stabling area is for immediate loading and unloading of horses and equipment. Please be respectful of other spectators and limit your trailer time in the stabling area to 30 minutes.

NIGHTWATCH: Each horse will be checked multiple times throughout each night during the show. With any questions or concerns about night watch, please contact Morgan Hurd. Night watch: Adam Hendon - 256.368.3266

SHARPS CONTAINERS: Sharps containers are provided in the stabling areas. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

SHOW OFFICE: Office will be open one hour before the earlier start time each show day. The office will also be open Thursday 2-4 and will be closed during the \$1500 Hunter Derby.

CHECK IN: Back numbers will not be issued to competitors without credit card information or a signed

open check, a copy of negative coggins test must be provided to the horse show secretary. There are no scratch/add fees. For your convenience, we now accept Visa and Mastercard. A 3% convenience fee will be added to all credit card transactions.

SCRATCHES: Scratches must be made in the office on the official add/scratch form prior to start of class. Once the class has begun, scratches will not be honored. Add/scratch will be available online Thursday through Saturday evening from 3:00 pm until 9:00 p.m. You are encouraged to use this online tool.

CHECK OUT: Please check out your exhibitor upon completion of their competition. Any discrepancies with your show bill must be within 24 hours after check out. If you have participated in a money class, results must be posted with the show office prior to check out.

NON-NEGOTIABLE CHECKS: Checks returned by the bank for any reason will be assessed a penalty of \$50 and restitution made immediately according to the AHJA 2021 Rule Book, sec.5.2.1.

DECLINED CREDIT CARDS: Credit cards declined for any reason will be assessed a penalty of \$50 and a check or cash left with the show secretary. Rules and procedures will be followed according to the AHJA 2021 Rule Book, sec. 5.2.2.

PARKING: All vehicles, including trailers, vans and campers, are prohibited from being parked in the stable areas. Vans and trailers will be allowed in the stable areas only to load and unload. **PARK IN DESIGNATED PARKING AREAS ONLY.**

HELMETS: ASTM/SEI approved helmets must be worn at all times for all riders on horseback regardless of age.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who sign the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a



minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistant devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**DOGS: ZERO TOLERANCE FOR LOOSE DOGS.** Dogs are not permitted to be loose on the competition grounds & must be on a leash or otherwise contained at all times. Individuals must not lead dogs while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damage, claims, losses, or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under sec. 5.1.2 of the AHJA 2021 Rule Book.

**NON-SHOWING HORSES:** no non-showing horses will be permitted at the 2021 AHJA Kick Off Show

**CAMPER HOOKUPS:** Limited number available on grounds. The cost is \$175 (Thursday – Sunday). Assigned on a first come first serve basis. Reservations must be submitted via email – AHJApresident@gmail.com. A \$500 fine for dumping any waste water on show grounds.

**RADIOS:** Barns who use hand held radios that are on the show radio frequency, or that interfere with show radios in any way will be required to discontinue the use of their radios during show hours.

**FEED & BEDDING:** Feed, hay and baled shavings will be available on the showgrounds and will be charged to your horse's account. All feed, hay, and bedding orders must be sent via email to [AHJApresident@gmail.com](mailto:AHJApresident@gmail.com). Any orders placed after noon on Saturday will not be guaranteed for delivery. Any orders placed after Friday's split deadline will need

to be paid separately by the trainer or whoever ordered the additional items.

**PRIZE MONEY:** Prize money will be applied to your horse's account only. If any prize money remains after show bill is paid, the AHJA will issue a check within 30 days after the show.

**MINOR EXHIBITORS:** Parent(s) or guardian(s) of a minor child shall hold the horse show management and the facility harmless for any injury to such minor. No minor child's entry will be accepted or number issued unless entry is signed by a parent, LEGAL guardian, or trainer. The signature of unrelated persons will not be accepted.

**DISPUTES:** In all classes, the Show Steward and Show Management will settle any disputes, arguments, conflicts or questions that may arise during the show and their decision shall be final.

**SCHOOLING:** In designated areas and times only.

**RIBBONS:** All AHJA classes offered herein will ribbon through 6th place. The Walk/Trot and Crosspole Divisions will ribbon through 10th place. Classics will ribbon through 6th place. Derbies will ribbon through 8th place.

**CONDUCT & DRUG USE –** Rules will be strictly enforced according to sec. 1.4 of the AHJA 2021 Rule Book.

**MEASUREMENT -** Entries for the Pony divisions must present a valid USEF or AHJA card or be measured before showing

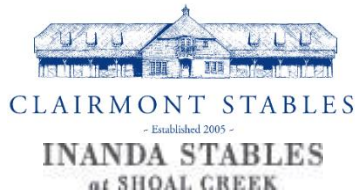
