Conditions of Entry:

1. Pre-entries will be accepted through online registration via HorseShowsOnline.com. Entry deadline is Wednesday Sept 8th. Post entries will be charged a late fee of \$30.00 per horse per rider. Please have proof of negative coggins. We accept cash, checks (made payable: Dean Equestrian).
2. Fees: a) Class Fee \$18 each for AHJA recognized – Team Challenge (main hunter ring only): \$25, warm-ups \$20 b) Late Entry Fee \$30 per horse per rider c) AHJA Non-Member Fee \$10 d) Facility Fee \$25 e) AHJA Office Fee \$10 per horse per rider f) Paramedic Fee \$10 per rider g) Stalls-VERY limited \$50 (includes shavings) h) Paddocks \$35, 12x12 Day Pen \$30 i) AHJA forms or waivers printed by the secretary \$5

3. Hard hats must be worn at all times while mounted, including schooling. All riders must wear ASTM-approved helmets. Appropriate hunt attire required in conjunction with AHJA rulebook.
4. The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, cancel any entries, disqualify exhibitors, prohibit showing of entries and cancel/edit awards of prizes without claims or damages. Management will abide by AHJA rules when combining divisions. Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to weather.
5. Open schooling will be allowed until 30 minutes prior to each ring's start time. We will water and drag rings before the first class. Schooling will be available Friday, Sept 10th from 1:00pm – 6:00pm
6. ALL dogs must be on a leash at all times.

9. Ten ribbons will be awarded in the walk-trot and crossrail divisions. All other divisions will pin through 6th. Champion and reserve hunter champion ribbons will be awarded along with a champion prize.
10. Show will be held in fenced all weather arenas. Schooling areas will be provided.
11. All scratches and adds must be done at the secretary's desk and proof of scratch/add must be taken to the in gate. No adds or scratches at the gate.
12. Concessions will be provided.
13. The show will run under the guidelines of the current AHJA Rulebook. Please see the AHJA website (alabamahunterjumpers.org) for all class specs and cross entering rules prior to entering. On show day the current AHJA Rulebook will be available at the secretary's desk.

****200.** \$500 Dean Equestrian Hunter TEAM Challenge \$25.00:

Rules: Open to all Junior riders showing in Hunter Ring 1. Teams of 4 will compete for winnings.

Riders must declare their teams/teammates and Division chosen to count as their Challenge Round by 7:45 am Sept 11th in the show office. We welcome teams to come up with a Team Name.

All declared TEAM members declared Second hunter rounds will be scored for the team hunter challenge. Teams of 4 will have their 2nd rounds scored and will drop their lowest score. The Top 3 team scores on each team of 4 will go towards the team total.

The Overall Team Champion is the team with the highest overall score of their highest 3 scores.

The goal of the Team Challenge is to build friendships and sportsmanship among all AHJA members from different State show barns while enjoying a Team competition.

Teams **MUST** have at least ONE team member from a DIFFERENT barn than their normal lesson barn/program.

So call your friends to build your 4 person teams. Example, a pony hunter rider and a Junior Hunter can be on the same team. It's encouraged to mix and match teammates to be more inclusive.

Each horse/rider combination may only have one round (their declared division 2nd Hunter round) count towards the Team Challenge.

Pinning through 6th – payout: \$40, \$30, \$25, \$15, \$10, \$5 for each rider on each team.. This class must have a minimum of 8 team entries; if less than 8 management has option to convert to a sweepstakes.

\$100 SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD

Any adult or child may nominate a junior rider that you witness exhibiting exemplary Sportsmanship. Write the persons full name and the reason or reasons you are nominating him or her. Nominations must include verbiage explaining sportsmanship witnessed to be a viable nomination.

A jar will be placed at the entrance of the show rings with notepads to nominate. The judges will read through all junior riders nominated and choose one winner to win the \$100 Sportsmanship Award.

AHJA Waiver & Release of Liability along with **Rolling Hills Release of Liability** is required for every exhibitor, signed by a parent or guardian only. Trainers cannot sign for their students. These must be submitted to the show secretary prior to receiving a back number.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

For and in consideration of the AHJA's acceptance of my entry, and allowing me, the undersigned, or my minor child, to participate in any capacity in an AHJA sanctioned or approved event or activity ("AHJA-sponsored event"), including but not limited to equestrian shows, competitions, clinics, practices and related or incidental activities and

events, and _____ I, for my myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs, executors and administrators, next of kin, successors and assigns, hereby agree as follows:

- A. AHJA RULES AND POLICIES: I agree to be bound and to abide by the rules and policies of the AHJA as published on its website at www.alabamahunterjumpers.org, and as amended periodically.
- B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with equestrian sports, and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that any AHJA-sponsored event involves risks and dangers, including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury, sickness and disease, including communicable diseases among humans or animals, trauma, pain and suffering, bites, kicks, abrasions, contusions or other injury or disability, allergic reactions, falls, paralysis, death, loss or damage to personal property, including without limitation to trailers, vehicles, tack, equipment, horses or other animals, and other unknown risks and dangers.

I specifically acknowledge that Alabama and the United States is currently battling the pandemic associated with COVID-19, a highly transmissible infectious disease, and agree that I will comply with any and all safety measures and social distancing protocols instituted by the AHJA and the AHJA-sponsored event, and further agree that I knowingly, willingly and voluntarily acknowledge and assume and take sole responsibility for the risks associated with participating in AHJA-sponsored events during the COVID-19 pandemic and its aftermath.

WARNING:

Under Alabama law, an equine activity sponsor or other equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to the Equine Activities Liability Protection Act.

I HEREBY VOLUNTARILY AND KNOWINGLY ASSUME ANY AND ALL SUCH RISKS AND AGREE THAT I AM SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGES, LIABILITIES, LOSSES, OR EXPENSES THAT I INCUR AS A RESULT OF MY, OR MY MINOR CHILD'S, PARTICIPATION IN ANY AHJA-SPONSORED EVENT. I ALSO AGREE TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY INJURY OR DAMAGE CAUSED BY ME, MY HORSE, MY SPOUSE OR CHILD, AND ANY OTHER PERSON OR ANIMAL ACTING UNDER MY DIRECTION AND CONTROL, AT ANY AHJA EVENT.

- C. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In consideration of my participation in any AHJA-sponsored event, I hereby release, waive, and agree not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the AHJA, its members, and members of its governing body, and all persons associated with AHJA activities, whether paid or volunteer, including all persons associated with _____ and its farm property, participants (including athletes/riders, coaches trainers, judges and other personnel), owners, guests, licensees, officials, show managers, grooms, employees, promoters, sponsors and advertisers, with respect to any liability claims, demands, causes of action, damages, losses, or expenses, including but not limited to court costs and attorneys' fees, of any kind which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in AHJA-sponsored events, including claims for liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the aforesaid persons.
- D. ELECTRONIC SIGNATURES: I agree that a facsimile, scanned or other form of my electronic signature on this Agreement is considered to be original and is as legally binding as my handwritten signature.
- E. MERGER AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: This Waiver and Release of Liability represents the complete agreement between the parties hereto, and no oral representations, statements or prior agreements have been made apart from the terms specified herein. If any provision of this Waiver and Release of Liability is held to be unlawful, void or unenforceable for any reason, then that provision shall be deemed severable and shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the remaining provisions.

I, _____ (Rider), am aware that riding, jumping and other activities involving horses are hazardous activities and I am voluntarily participating in these activities and/or instruction with knowledge of the danger involved, and hereby agree to accept any and all risks of injury or death. Furthermore, the undersigned acknowledges and understands that horseback riding or any other participation

in activities organized, run, or offered by ROLLING HILLS EQUESTRIAN CENTER may involve substantial risk of bodily injury, property damage and other dangers including, but not limited to, bodily injury or death resulting from kicks and bites, falling off horses or horses falling on Rider, being dragged by a foot caught in the stirrups, Rider being thrown by horse, equipment failure or collision with horses or vehicles or other inanimate objects.

The term Rider shall mean not only the undersigned, but also, any minor of the undersigned, and also any person who uses any portion of the property, equipment, horses or facilities of ROLLING HILLS EQUESTRIAN CENTER or participates on any activities provided by ROLLING HILLS EQUESTRIAN CENTER including but limited to lessons, clinics, or instructions with permission of the undersigned. Undersigned hereby releases PEGGY BRADFORD, ROLLING HILLS EQUESTRIAN CENTER, any landowner, their agents, employees, successors, assigns, legal representatives, heirs, executors and administrators from any and all claims, causes of action, demands, obligations and liabilities — which are now existing or hereafter mature or accrue at any time — arising out of or related in any fashion from Rider's participation in riding, jumping and other activities provided.
