Conditions of Entry

1. Pre-entries will be accepted through online registration via HorseShowsOnline.com. Entry deadline is Wednesday May 2, 2018. Post entries will be charged a late fee of \$50.00 per horse per rider. Please have proof of negative Coggins. We only accept cash and checks.
2. Fees:
 - a. Class Fee: \$18 each for AHJA recognized - Classic: \$35 - Best Child Rider: \$5 (must have armband)
 - b. Late Entry Fee: \$50 per horse per rider
 - c. AHJA Non-Member Fee: \$10 per rider
 - d. AHJA Secretary Fee: \$10 per horse per rider
 - e. Overnight Stalls: \$50 (includes shavings and cleaning) – Contact Guerry Force – (205)381-0364 **SOLD OUT**
 - i. Additionally, very limited day stalls are available starting at 7:00 am on Saturday May 5th – no exceptions
 - f. Paramedic: \$8 per rider
3. Hard hats must be worn at all times while mounted, including schooling. All riders must wear ASTM-approved helmets. Appropriate hunt attire required.
4. The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or cancel any entries, disqualify exhibitors, prohibit showing of entries and cancel/edit awards of prizes without claims or damages. Management will abide by AHJA rules when combining divisions. Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to weather.
5. Current AHJA rules will be available at the show secretary's desk.
6. **NO WARM UP ROUNDS** – Schooling breaks are posted in the schedule for each ring. Please plan accordingly.
7. Open schooling will be allowed until 30 minutes prior to each ring's start time. We will water and drag rings before the first class. Schooling will be available Friday May 4th from 1:00 pm -6:00 pm. Only lunge in ring 4
8. ALL dogs must be on a leash at all times.
9. Veterinarian on call: Coosa Valley Equine (205)753-0451
10. Farrier on call: Dustin Siegler (205)753-9105
11. Ten ribbons will be awarded in the walk-trot and crossrail divisions. All other divisions will pin through 6th. Champion and reserve champion ribbons will be awarded along with a champion prize.
12. Please observe the dotted line in both hunter rings 1 and 2.
13. Show will be held in fenced sand arenas.
14. Horses will not be excused from showing without a veterinarian's certificate showing illness or incapacity of mount. This must be received by the show secretary by the end of the show.
15. All scratches and adds must be done at the secretary's desk and proof of scratch/add must be taken to the in gate. No adds or scratches at the gate.

Hunter Classics, Best Child Rider, Academy Classes and Lead Line

*200. **\$500 Fig Street Marketing Group Hunter Classic entry fee - \$35.00:** Open to all riders showing in children's pony, regular pony, pre-child/adult hunter, baby green hunter, modified hunter, low hunter, children's hunter, adult amateur hunter and junior/AO hunter. Second hunter rounds will be scored as the first round of the classic. All entries will return for a second round. Second classic round is to be done concurrently with each division and taken after the final regular division round. The two round scores will be combined and prizes awarded at the end of the day. Each horse rider combinations may only show in one classic and only enter one time. Pinning through 8th – payout: \$130, \$85, \$85, \$55, \$55, \$30, \$30, \$30

201. **Best Child Rider on a Pony Ring I - \$5.00-** open to all junior riders on a pony in hunter ring I who are showing in schooling pony, children's pony and regular pony. This award will be given out to the pony rider who the judge feels best displays riding talent, horsemanship and sportsmanship during the show day. Riders must display the colored armband to be considered for this award. Armbands will be given out by the secretary. Riders may only compete in one best child rider category.

202. **Best Child Rider on a Horse Ring I - \$5.00** – Open to all junior riders (on a horse) in hunter ring I who are showing in schooling hunter, pre-child, low hunter, modified hunter, baby green, children's hunter, junior hunter and regular working. This award will be given out to the junior rider who the judge feels best displays riding talent, horsemanship and sportsmanship during the show day. Riders must display the colored armband to be considered for this award. Armbands will be given out by the secretary. Riders may only compete in one best child rider category.

203. **Best Child Rider on a Pony Ring II - \$5.00** – Open to all junior riders (on a pony) in hunter ring II who are showing in walk-trot, crossrails, hopeful hunter, short stirrup, long stirrup and starting hunter. This award will be given out to the pony rider who the judge feels best displays riding talent, horsemanship and sportsmanship during the show day. Riders must display the colored armband to be considered for this award. Armbands will be given out by the secretary. Riders may only compete in one best child rider category.

204. **Best Child Rider on a Horse Ring II- \$5.00** – Open to all junior riders (on a horse) in hunter ring II who are showing in walk-trot, crossrails, hopeful hunter, short stirrup, long stirrup and starting hunter. This award will be given out to the junior rider on a horse who the judge feels best displays riding talent, horsemanship and sportsmanship during the show day. Riders must display the colored armband to be considered for this award. Armbands will be given out by the secretary. Riders may only compete in one best child rider category.
