GENERAL FEES

Facility Fee: \$ 15 Assessed all riders

AHJA Office Fee: \$10 assessed all riders

Late Entry Fee: \$30 Assessed per rider after Wednesday, Sept 22, 2021.

Paramedic Fee: \$10 Assessed all riders

Proper hunt attire is required for all recognized hunter classes.

Academy classes are open to all riders. Proper hunt attire is not required. Chaps are allowed in these classes.

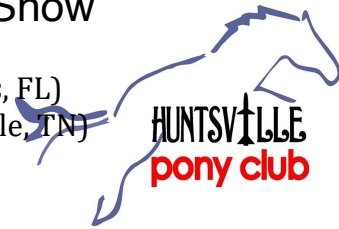

BILL WOLF MEMORIAL CLASSIC: The first round of the Bill Wolf Memorial Classic will be the second round of you declared division. Ensure that you let the Show Secretary know what division you are using for you Classic. One division per rider/horse. The second round of the Bill Wolf Memorial Classic will immediately follow your second round in your declared division. Purse \$500: 1st Place: \$200, 2nd Place: \$150, 3rd Place: \$75, 4th Place: \$50, and 5th Place: \$25.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION - 1) Online entry information and a complete description of divisions and cross entering information, please visit www.horseshowsonline.com. 2) Owners and exhibitors are responsible for all horses and fees incurred by them or their agents, even though payment may not be submitted along with entry 3) Pre-entry deadline is Wednesday, September 22, 2021. All entries received after said date will be treated as post-entries and charged a late entry fee. NO EXCEPTIONS. 4) AHJA Membership forms are available online and at the show secretary's desk. Individual: \$35 Family: \$60 Stable: \$75 Lifetime Individual: \$350
PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR - ASTM/SEI approved helmets must be worn at all times for all riders on horseback, regardless of age.

MEDICAL SERVICES - Emergency Medical personal are available.

TROPHIES & RIBBONS - Every AHJA class offered herein will be placed 1st-6th and awarded five ribbons. The Walk/Trot and Crosspole Divisions will be awarded 10 ribbons.

CHAMPION AND RESERVE - Awarded based on 10, 6, 4, 3, 2, and 1.5 in all Hunter divisions.

DISCOURTESY - To any Show Official by any owner, rider, trainer, handler or groom will disqualify any horses with which they are associated and fees for horses forfeited.

STALLS AND BEDDING - Limited stalls and paddocks are available starting the day before the show. Stalls will be assigned upon completion of arrangements with the Show Manager, BJ Brown. TEXT BJ at 256.603.0857 for stall and shavings reservations by Wednesday, September 22, 2021 by 6:00 pm.

SCHOOLING - In designated areas only. Open schooling is allowed Friday until 7 pm and 30 minutes prior to the arena start times Saturday and Sunday.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES- dirt bikes, golf carts. Only licensed drivers allowed to drive any motor vehicle.

CONCESSIONS - will be available on the Show Grounds provided Saturday.

DOGS - Must be leashed and under control of the owner or dog may be impounded.

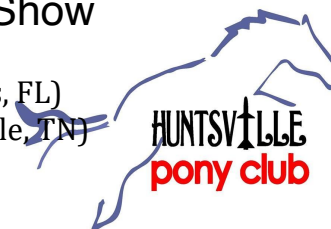
COGGINS TEST - Negative certificates dated within 1 year are required for admittance with state and local laws.

Due to the recent outbreak of COVID-19 the Alabama Hunter Jumper Association will be taking extra precautions for the remainder of the 2020 show season. Anyone choosing to attend an AHJA recognized show is coming at their own risk and by attending you are taking sole responsibility for yourself and anyone under your supervision.

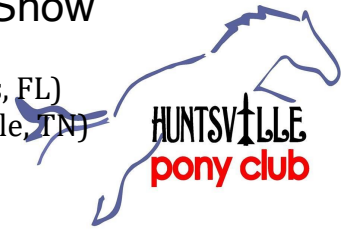
1. To receive admittance to any AHJA sanctioned horse show exhibitors, trainers, grooms, horse show officials, guardians, and essential personnel, etc. must:
 - a. Not have anyone in their household test positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
 - b. Not been advised by any healthcare professional to self-quarantine nor has been in contact with someone who has test positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
 - c. Not shown any symptoms of COVID-19 in the last 24-48 hours. Symptoms include, but are not limited to, a fever over 100.4, cough, or shortness of breath.
 - d. Must be willing to adhere to all policies implemented by the AHJA and additional policies implemented by the host farm. Any person found not in accordance may be asked to leave or wait in their car by the show managers, show steward, show secretary, or AHJA president.
2. Anyone on property must maintain "social distancing" and keep 6' of space between themselves and others in accordance with federal, state and local guidelines.
3. Any vehicle or trailer is subject to inspection to ensure that only the necessary parties are admitted.
4. NO outside spectators are allowed.
5. Horse Show Office Procedures
 - a. There will be one representative per farm/trainer. This representative will be the only one allowed in the show office per farm/trainer.
 - b. This representative will be responsible for collecting payments (checks or cash) from all clients from the same barn or trainer and turn in payment to the secretaries in exchange for back numbers. Those paying in cash must use the prize list to calculate their total. Cash must be turned in at the beginning of the day.
 - c. Secretaries will email all receipts to the trainers listed on the entry. Trainers are responsible for distributing receipts.
 - d. Only one person will be allowed in the show office at a time.
 - e. Adds and scratches will need to be done online – this will be open until 8:00 pm the night before.
6. Trainers are responsible for making sure their customers and additional personnel adhere to all rules. By coming to the horse show they are taking responsibility of their clients and will be held liable for any action not in accordance with these guidelines. Before entering the show grounds, they need to review the new policies with all persons coming under their supervision.
7. Wearing a facemask is recommended at all times when not mounted, and exhibitors will not be penalized for wearing facemasks during their rounds..
8. When lining up for under saddler/equation on the flat classes riders need to maintain 6' between themselves and all other competitors
9. You are not permitted to allow social gatherings of 10 or more persons, parties, or in-show events.
10. Show staff will sanitize common spaces throughout the day. These spaces include, but not limited to: port-o-lets, bathroom facilities, door knobs, schooling jumps, wash stalls, community watering spickets, in-gate and ribbon tables, course boards, and any other "high traffic" area.
11. Hand washing or sanitization stations will be available on property. However, it is recommended that attendees bring their own supplies as well.

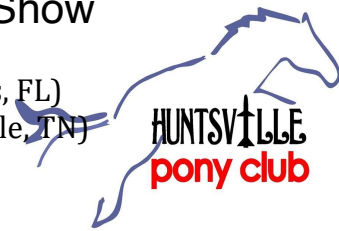

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

For and in consideration of the AHJA's acceptance of my entry, and allowing me, the undersigned, or my minor child, to participate in any capacity in an AHJA sanctioned or approved event or activity ("AHJA-sponsored event"), including but not limited to equestrian shows, competitions, clinics, practices and related or incidental activities and events, and _____ (insert specific AHJA-sponsored event), I, for my myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs, executors and administrators, next of kin, successors and assigns, hereby agree as follows:

- A. AHJA RULES AND POLICIES: I agree to be bound and to abide by the rules and policies of the AHJA as published on its website at www.alabamahunterjumpers.org, and as amended periodically.
- B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with equestrian sports, and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that any AHJA-sponsored event involves risks and dangers, including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury, sickness and disease, including communicable diseases among humans or animals, trauma, pain and suffering, bites, kicks, abrasions, contusions or other injury or disability, allergic reactions, falls, paralysis, death, loss or damage to personal property, including without limitation to trailers, vehicles, tack, equipment, horses or other animals, and other unknown risks and dangers.

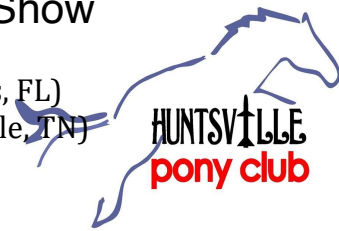
